5. A third of the way down from the eye line is where the mouth will go. This is where the mouth will go.



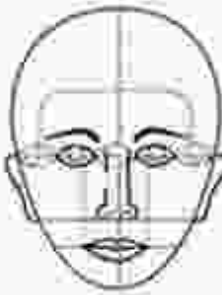
6. Draw in the eyes with the corners of the face. To ensure the eyes are the correct size you should be able to fit the pupil in the width of the face.



7. Draw the bridge of the nose. The bridge of the nose is the same width as the eyes.



8. Draw in the mouth with the lips. Remember that the lips are the same width as the eyes and the corners of the eyes are the same distance from the center of the face.



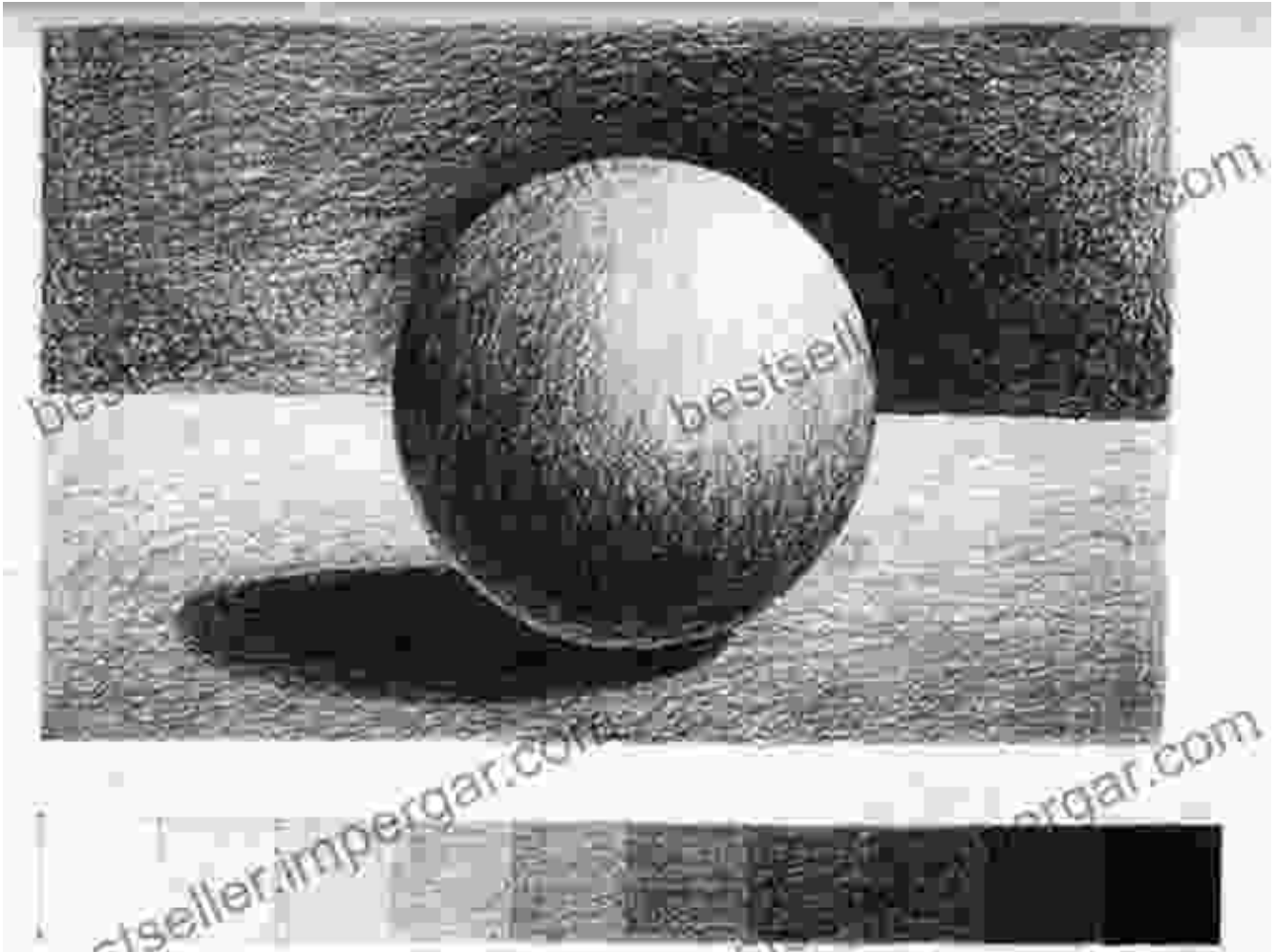
9. Draw in the ears and the hairline. The hairline can vary between the eyes and the top of the face. Remember the ears should fit snugly between the eye and nose lines.



10. Draw the shading around the face. Remember that the shading should be the same on each side to create the correct look.

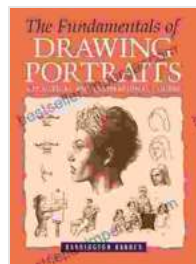

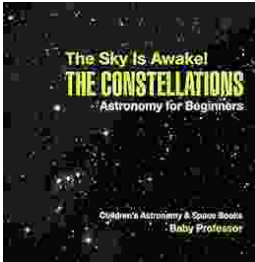

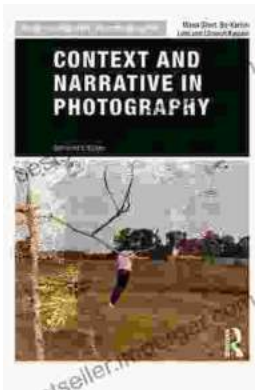
